#### **Project Status**

Predesign was completed on 7/31/07 and design was completed on 11/26/08. Project was advertised for bids on 12/11/08. 20 bids were received on 1/21/09. The project was put on hold in December 2008 due to the State funding freeze. On 12/17/09 the L.A. for Kids Steering Committee approved the necessary cash flow loans to allow the project to proceed. Staff has determined that it is more beneficial to rebid the project. The Board of Recreation and Parks approved the project rebid on 2/17/10. Receipt of bids was advertised for 3/30/10, but was extended to 4/27/10. Eighteen (18) bids were received on 4/27/10. Bids are ranged from \$720,885 to \$1,153,700. The median price is \$937,292. The lowest bid is \$720,885. The project was awarded on 6/16/10 for construction. Currently the contract has executed, and pre-construction meeting was held on
